SCOPE

The British Judo Inclusion Commission wish to appoint one or two exceptional individuals to act as coaches to support Special Needs judo.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Current Senior Club Coach or Club Coach or minimum Level 2 UKCC coach award
- Current British Judo Association member
- Minimum 1st Dan

RESPONSIBILITIES and DUTIES

- 1) Liaison with SN Club Coaches within the UK
- 2) Take responsibility for SN coaching sessions
- 3) Ensure that all coaching/training sessions are planned in advance
- 4) It is expected that the GB SN Coach will arrange regular training sessions with all Judoka Male/Female, Senior/Junior
- 5) Offer feedback on player/team performances
- 6) Attend competitions with team/players at home and abroad
- 7) Report on team/player progress
- 8) Assist with team selection (where appropriate)
- 9) Liaison with Inclusion Coaching Team and British Judo lead Delivery Officer to include the requirements of the British Judo delivery programme

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This voluntary and self-funded role is reviewed on an annual basis. The role is performance based and on the requirements of the role.
