IJF ANTI-DOPING RULES AMENDMENTS

[...]

5.2 Authority to conduct *Testing*

- **5.2.1** Subject to the jurisdictional limitations for *Event Testing* set out in Article 5.3 of the *Code*, IJF shall have *In-Competition* and *Out-of-Competition Testing* authority over all of the *Athletes* specified in the Introduction to these Anti-Doping Rules (under the heading "Scope"). IJF delegates *In-Competition Testing* authority to its *Continental Unions* for *Continental Events*.
- **5.2.2** IJF may require any *Athlete* over whom it has *Testing* authority (including any *Athlete* serving a period of *Ineligibility*) to provide a *Sample* at any time and at any place.

[...]

7.1 Responsibility for Conducting Results Management

- **7.1.1** The circumstances in which IJF shall take responsibility for conducting results management in respect of anti-doping rule violations involving *Athletes* and other *Persons* under its jurisdiction shall be determined by reference to and in accordance with Article 7 of the *Code*.
- **7.1.2** Subject to Article 7.1 of the *Code*, IJF is the Results Management Authority of cases arising from *IJF Events*.
 - 7.1.2.1 Subject to Article 7.1 of the *Code*, cases arising from *Continental Events* are to be managed by the respective and authorized, as listed in **APPENDIX 4**, *Unions*.
- **7.1.3** The IJF Anti-Doping Coordinator or its delegate shall conduct the review set forth in article 7.2, 7.3, 7.4, 7.5, 7.6; the Medical Commission shall conduct the review set forth in article 7.4 and 7.5. The review set forth in article 7.7 shall be conducted by a Doping Review Panel appointed ad hoc by the Executive Committee consisting of a Chair and at least 2 other members with experience in anti-doping and/or investigations.

[...]

7.10.2 Waiver of hearing

7.10.2.1 An *Athlete* or other *Person* against whom an antidoping rule violation is asserted may waive a hearing expressly by indicating so on the form provided in **Annex A** of these Rules.

7.10.2.2 Alternatively, if the *Athlete* or other *Person* against whom an anti-doping rule violation is asserted fails to request a hearing and/or to dispute that assertion within the deadline specified in the notice sent by the IJF's Anti-Doping Coordinator asserting the violation, then he/she shall be deemed to have admitted the violation and to have waived a hearing.

7.10.2.3 In cases where Article 7.10.2.1 or Article 7.10.2.2 applies, a hearing before a hearing panel shall not be required. Instead, the IJF's Anti-Doping Coordinator will refer the case to the IJF Hearing Panel Medical Commission, transmitting all the available documents of the case.

The IJF Hearing Panel Medical Commission shall promptly issue a written recommendation to the IJF Executive Committee for adjudication and final decision in accordance with Article 8.2, about the commission of the anti-doping rule violation and the Consequences imposed as a result, and setting out the full reasons for any period of Ineligibility imposed, including (if applicable) a justification for why the maximum potential period of Ineligibility was not imposed. IJF Executive Committee shall send copies of that decision to other Anti-Doping Organizations with a right to appeal under Article 13.2.3, and shall Publicly Disclose that decision in accordance with Article 14.3.2.

[...]

ARTICLE 8 RIGHT TO A FAIR HEARING

8.1 Principles for a Fair Hearing

8.1.1 When IJF sends a notice to an *Athlete* or other *Person* asserting an anti-doping rule violation, and the *Athlete* or other *Person* does not waive a hearing in accordance with Article 7.10.1 or Article 7.10.2, then the case shall be referred to the Hearing Panel Medical Commission on behalf of the IJF Executive Committee for hearing.

8.1.2 Hearings shall be scheduled and completed within a reasonable time. Hearings held in connection with *Events* that are subject to these Anti-Doping Rules may be conducted by an expedited process where permitted by the hearing panel.

[Comment to Article 8.1.2: For example, a hearing could be expedited on the eve of a major Event where the resolution of the anti-doping rule violation is necessary to determine the Athlete's eligibility to participate in the Event, or during an Event where the resolution of the case will affect the validity of the Athlete's results or continued participation in the Event.]

8.1.3 The IJF <u>Hearing Panel</u> <u>Medical Commission</u> shall conduct hearings electronically and in English.

- **8.1.4** WADA and the National Federation of the Athlete or other Person may be included in the electronic correspondence as observers. In any event, IJF shall keep WADA fully apprised as to the status of pending cases and the result of all hearings.
- **8.1.5** The IJF <u>Hearing Panel</u> <u>Medical Commission</u> and **Executive Committee** shall act in a fair and impartial manner towards all parties at all times. **Any members of the <u>Hearing Panel</u>** <u>Medical Commission</u> or Executive Committee of the same nationality as the *Athlete* are excluded from the process, and the final decision.

8.2 Decisions

8.2.1 At the end of the hearing, or on a timely basis thereafter, based on the recommendation of the IJF Hearing Panel Medical Commission the IJF Executive Committee shall issue a written decision that includes the full reasons for the decision and for any period of *Ineligibility* imposed, including (if applicable) a justification for why the greatest potential *Consequences* were not imposed.

APPENDIX 1 DEFINITIONS

Continental Events: Events organized by or under the supervision of the Unions

[...]

<u>IJF Event</u>: Events organized by or under the supervision of IJF <u>and its Unions</u> as listed in IJF and its Unions' calendars that give points in the IJF World Ranking List, and the <u>including Grand Slam, Grand Prix, Masters, World Championships,</u> Olympic and Youth Olympic Games.

IJF RTP: The criteria and the list of the athletes can be found in the IJF website. All *Athletes* who are ranked in the TOP 6 of their weight category. Ranking is revised after World Championships or Olympic Games. The new set of *Athletes* is in effect from the 1st day of the second consecutive month after the relevant *Event*. *Athletes* are notified about inclusion or exclusion in the *IJF RTP* as set out in Article 5.6.1 of these Rules.
