<b>Entry process</b>	<p>Entry is via the British Judo online booking tool at <a href="http://www.britishjudo.org.uk/enteronline">www.britishjudo.org.uk/enteronline</a>.</p> <p>Entry via the online system takes only a couple of minutes to complete and will ensure that your entry is processed correctly and the payment is processed immediately via our secure system. You will receive an entry confirmation email.</p> <p><b>This entry confirmation email is simply confirming that your entry process is complete, it is NOT confirming that the system has checked your licence is in date or that you meet the minimum grade requirement – this is still your responsibility.</b></p> <p>To enter either the Pre Cadet or Cadet British Championships players are requested to consider that either Great Britain, England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland are their home country and the country of which they wish to represent internationally.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>All entries must be received by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2017</b> (The online entry system will open Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2017)</p>
<b>Participation</b>	<p>To enter the Pre-Cadet or Cadet British Championships, players are requested to consider that either England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland is the country they wish to represent. All players MUST be eligible to represent GBR internationally.</p> <p><b>Competitors must hold current BJA or affiliate membership. All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership card (or Licence Slip) to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade.</b></p>
<b>Age Band: Pre Cadet Players born in the years 2004 and 2005</b>	<p><b>Girls:</b> Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2017 <b>Boys:</b> Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2017 <b>Minimum grade:</b> Green belt <b>Maximum Contest Duration:</b> Three minutes <b>Rules:</b> Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza are NOT permitted in all categories for Pre Cadets</p>
<b>Age Band: Cadets Players born in years 2001, 2002 and 2003</b>	<p><b>Boys:</b> Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2017 <b>Girls:</b> Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2017 <b>Minimum grade:</b> Green belt <b>Maximum Contest Duration:</b> Four minutes <b>Rules:</b> Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza are permitted in all categories for Cadets</p>
<b>Competition and Judogi Rules</b>	<p>IJF Rules will be in operation, with the following British Concessions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No 30 second rule</li> <li>• Judogi measurements as per 2013 IJF rules. It is however recommended that players wear judogi that meet the 2017 IJF rules to help prepare them for future requirements and international competition. <a href="#">Click here for 2017 IJF Judogi rule Document.</a></li> <li>• 2017 IJF Measurements, Red label judogi or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition.</li> </ul> <p>Please note that the British Championships will strictly adhere to the mat side coaching rule in all categories as follows:</p> <p>Coaches in the official mat side position can only advise the athlete during the mate-hajime period and</p>

	<p>NOT while the contest is in progress. Should any mat side coach not adhere to this guideline they will firstly be reminded of this rule by the referee and on receiving the second reminder in the same contest will need to remove themselves to the general public area for the rest of the event on that day. Other personnel who insist on shouting coaching points will also need to remove themselves to the general public seating area.</p> <p><b>The wearing of white &amp; blue judogi is COMPULSORY for this event.</b></p> <p>The competitor called for a contest first must wear a white suit. The competitor called for a contest second must wear a blue suit. All competitors must wear a belt of which is appropriate to their grade.</p> <p><b>Back Patches</b> Only judogi back patches of GBR, SCO, NIR, WAL, and ENG are allowed to be worn. Back patches that state a different country must be removed before competition. You will not be allowed to compete with a back patch showing a federation outside of Great Britain. Back patches are not obligatory.</p>
<p><b>Competition Format</b></p>	<p>Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout.</p> <p>This tournament is points scoring for promotion purposes.</p>
<p><b>Seeding</b></p>	<p>For the Pre-Cadets, the top eight players will be seeded using the Pre-Cadet Ippon League tables.</p> <p>For the Cadets, the top eight players will be seeded using the Cadet Ippon League tables.</p>
<p><b>Weight Categories</b></p>	<p>Pre Cadet Boys: -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg +73kg Pre Cadet Girls: -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg +70kg</p> <p>Cadet Boys: -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, U90kg, +90kg Cadet Girls: -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg</p>
<p><b>Registration &amp; Weigh-In</b></p>	<p><b>Cadet Boys – Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2017:</b> 07:30hrs - 08:30hrs EIS, Sheffield Badminton Hall</p> <p><b>Pre Cadet Girls– Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2017:</b> 12:00hrs - 13:00hrs EIS, Sheffield Badminton Hall</p> <p><b>Cadet Girls – Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2017:</b> 07:30hrs - 08:30hrs EIS, Sheffield Badminton Hall</p> <p><b>Pre Cadet Boys – Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2017:</b> 10:00hrs - 11:00hrs EIS, Sheffield Badminton Hall</p> <p><b>Competition starts:</b> 09:30hrs on both days</p> <p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> bring their <b>VALID</b> judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and their record book showing they meet the minimum grade.</p> <p>Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, i.e. for -73kg players must weigh a minimum of 66.6kg.</p> <p>Players are able to change weight category, to a higher or lower category, at registration.</p> <p><b>Please note: Weight category changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh-in scales.</b></p> <p>Players must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers (and a t-shirt for female players) and will receive the appropriate weight allowance.</p> <p><b>Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area. Please use the changing rooms.</b></p>
