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APPENDIX 1: TYPES OF INTEREST	
Type of Interest	Description
Financial Interests	<p>This is where an individual may get direct financial benefits from the consequences of a commissioning decision. This could, for example, include being:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A director, including a non-executive director, or senior employee in a private company or public limited company or other organisation which is doing, or which is likely, or possibly seeking to do, business with BJA or other related organisations; • A shareholder (or similar owner interests), a partner or owner of a private or not-for-profit company, business, partnership or consultancy which is doing, or which is likely, or possibly seeking to do, business with BJA or other related organisations; • A management consultant for a provider to BJA; • In secondary employment; • In receipt of secondary income from a provider to BJA; • In receipt of a grant from a provider to BJA; • In receipt of any payments (for example honoraria, one off payments, day allowances or travel or subsistence) from a provider; • Membership of Advisory Boards and panels (paid or unpaid);
Non-Financial Professional Interests	<p>This is where an individual may obtain a non-financial benefit from the consequences of decision, such as increasing their professional reputation or status or promoting their professional career.</p>
Non-Financial Personal Interests	<p>This is where an individual may benefit personally in ways which are not directly linked to their professional career and do not give rise to a direct financial benefit. This could include, for example, where the individual is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A voluntary sector champion for a provider to BJA or other related organisations; • A volunteer for a provider to BJA or other related organisations; • A member of a voluntary sector Governing Body or has any other position of authority in or in connection with a voluntary sector organisation.
Indirect Interests	<p>This is where an individual has a close association with an individual who has a financial interest, a non-financial professional interest or a non-financial personal interest in a decision (as those categories are described above).
