Financial Interests	 Description This is where an individual may get direct financial benefits from the consequences of a commissioning decision. This could, for example, include being: A director, including a non-executive director, or senior employee in a private company or public limited company or other organisation which is doing, or which is likely, or possibly seeking to do, business with BJA or other related organisations; A shareholder (or similar owner interests), a partner or owner of a private or not-for-profit company, business, partnership or consultancy which is doing, or which is likely, or possibly seeking to do, business with BJA or other related organisations; A management consultant for a provider to BJA; In receipt of secondary income form a provider to BJA; In receipt of any payments (for example honoraria, one off payments, day allowances or travel or subsistence) from a provider;
Non-Financial Professional Interests	This is where an individual may obtain a non-financial benefit from the consequences of decision, such as increasing their professional reputation or status or promoting their professional career.
Non-Financial Personal Interests	 This is where an individual may benefit personally in ways which are not directly linked to their professional career and do not give rise to a direct financial benefit. This could include, for example, where the individual is: A voluntary sector champion for a provider to BJA or other related organisations; A volunteer for a provider to BJA or other related organisations; A member of a voluntary sector Governing Body or has any other position of authority in or in connection with a voluntary sector organisation.
Indirect Interests	 This is where an individual has a close association with an individual who has a financial interest, a non-financial professional interest or a non-financial personal interest in a decision (as those categories are described above). For example, this should include: Spouse/partner; Close relative, eg. parent, grandparent, child, grandchild or sibling; Close friend; Business partner.

DECLARATION OF GOOD CHARACTER

I declare that:

- I have not been subject to a direct or indirect sanction, suspension, ban or other form of disqualification from, or in connection with, my involvement in: (i) the administration of sport; (ii) sport as a participant; and/or (iii) work as a sports agent / intermediary / other representative, in each case by any sports governing body (or similar body), including in respect of any matters relating to anti-doping or corruption;
- 2. I have not been subject to a sanction, suspension or ban or other form of disqualification or striking-off by a professional body (including, but not limited to, the Solicitor's Regulation Authority, Bar Council, the Institute of Chartered Accountants or equivalent bodies in other jurisdictions);
- 3. I do not have an unspent conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction anywhere in the world in respect of any offence involving dishonesty, corruption, perverting the court of justice or which constitutes a serious breach of the Companies Act 1985 or Companies Act 2006;
- 4. I am not required to notify the police of personal information in accordance with the Sex Offenders Act 2003 or equivalent legislation in any other jurisdiction nor have I been included on the Violent and Sex Offender Register or equivalent register in any other jurisdiction;
