Participation Criteria:	<p>All players must currently hold a valid British Passport and be eligible to represent Great Britain internationally. Players already registered on the IJF Judobase system must be registered under GBR. If a player has a British Passport but are registered on the IJF Judobase for another nation, then entry is not allowed for this competition.</p> <p>The British Judo Events Team and Performance Team reserve the right to request eligibility documentation during the entry process, if we have not seen it previously. If requested eligibility documentation is not provided, then a players' entry will be withdrawn.</p> <p>Competitors must hold current BJA or affiliate membership. All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership card to registration along with their record book which shows they meet the minimum grade.</p>

Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza are not permitted in all categories for Pre Cadets.</p> <p>Pre-Cadet Male: -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, +73kg Pre-Cadet Female: -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg</p> <p><u>Cadets:</u> Year of birth: 2005, 2006 or 2007 Minimum grade: 10th Mon Green Belt Contest duration: All contests will be 4 minute duration.</p>

<p>Registration and Weigh Ins:</p>	<p>All weigh ins are carried out in the EIS basketball hall.</p> <p>Pre Cadet Male: Sunday 5th December, 10:00-11:00am Pre Cadet Female: Saturday 4th December, 12:00-13:00pm</p> <p>Cadet Male: Saturday 4th December, 07:30-08:30am Cadet Female: Sunday 5th December, 07:30-08:30am</p> <p>Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the organisers must be notified of any weight category changes).</p>
<p>Competition Format, Rules and Judoji Rules:</p>	<p>Knockout with compound repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout. Dependant on entry numbers the format may change, this is at the discretion of the Tournament Director.</p> <p>Contest times will be 3 minutes for Pre Cadets and 4 minutes for Cadets.</p> <p>IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No 30 second rule • Judoji measurements as per 2017 IJF rules. • 2017 IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition. <p>Back Patches: Only judogi back patches of GBR, SCO, NIR, WAL, and ENG are allowed to be worn. Back patches that state a different country must be removed before competition. You will not be allowed to compete with a back patch showing a federation outside of Great Britain. Back patches are not obligatory.</p> <p>The wearing of white & blue judogi is COMPULSORY for this event. The competitor called for a contest first must wear a white suit. The competitor called for a contest second must wear a blue suit. All competitors must wear a belt which is appropriate to their grade.</p> <p>This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes. Competition starts: 09:30hrs on both days.</p>

Seeding:	<p>For the Pre-Cadets, the top eight players will be seeded using the Pre-Cadet Ippon League tables.</p> <p>For the Cadets, the top eight players will be seeded using the Cadet Ippon League tables.</p> <p>Due to the pandemic and break in competition the final seeding may be different from the above, this will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.</p>
Entry Fee:	<p>£30 per person</p> <p>£50 per person for double entry (CAD & JUN/ JUN & SEN)</p>
Photography/ Filming:	<p>By entering the event, all participants and parents or guardians of participants are consenting to photography/filming which may be taken by the BJA or an official BJA contractor at the event. You also accept that these photographs or video may be used in future BJA publications or published by the contractors. Coaching Passes:	<p>Coaches MUST produce a VALID BJA Coach Award card in person in order to be eligible for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To gain entry free of charge • To gain mat side access with their player (Level 2 & matside) <p>The British Championships will be strictly adhering to the mat side coaching rule in all categories. In the following way:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coaches in the official mat side position can only advise the athlete during the mate-hajime period and NOT while the contest is in progress. • Should any mat side coach not adhere to this guideline they will firstly be reminded of this rule by the referee and on receiving the second reminder in the same contest will need to remove themselves to the general public area for the rest of the event on that day. • Other personnel who insist on shouting coaching points will also need to remove themselves to the general public seating area. • Dress code: track suit or suit for final blocks/pools
