	allowed to compete with a back patch showing a federation
	outside of Great Britain. Back patches are not obligatory.
	The wearing of white & blue judogi is COMPULSORY for this
	event. The competitor called for a contest first must wear a white
	suit. The competitor called for a contest second must wear a blue
	suit. All competitors must wear a belt which is appropriate to
	their grade.
	This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes. Competition starts: 09:30brs on both days.
