

## Eligibility to take part in British Judo Events

### Membership and Insurance

To participate in any British Judo event as a Judoka, Official or Referee normally requires that participant to have a currently valid membership of British Judo, however, there are exceptions:

#### British Exceptions:

Those participants who have a currently valid membership of either the British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association are also accepted and insured as an affiliate of the British Judo Association.

Those participants who have a currently valid membership of either Judo Scotland, Welsh Judo or the Northern Ireland Judo Association are also accepted and insured for British Judo Association events.

#### Non-British Exceptions:

Those participants who have a currently valid membership of an IJF affiliated country AND proof of liability insurance are also permitted to participate in British Judo events.

#### Proof of Membership and Insurance:

In all cases without exception, it is the **participants responsibility to prove** if requested to do so their membership status and associated insurance cover where applicable. There are no mitigating reasons accepted for not being able to prove beyond reasonable doubt that the participant has appropriate membership and insurance cover before the event starts.

In the case of British Judo, British Judo Council, Amateur Judo Association, Judo Scotland, Welsh Judo, and the Northern Ireland Judo Association proof of valid membership will also be accepted as proof of appropriate insurance cover.

In the case of participants from an IJF affiliated country, they must provide clear evidence of their valid membership of that IJF affiliated country and a valid personal liability insurance cover before being allowed to take part in the applicable event.
