Participation:	<p>Boys and Girls who are a minimum of 8 years old up to and including 15 years old on the day. Competitors must be members of the British Judo Association, or British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association.</p> <p>Competitors must be a minimum of Orange belt and a maximum of Blue belt.</p>
Mode:	<p>Players will be check-weighed-in, on the day (at the venue) and will have at least three fights. The Organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club but emphasis will be concentrated in trying to keep players together in groups of similar age/weight/grade and experience.</p> <p>Each competitor will receive a medal.</p> <p>Medals will be presented after each group finishes.</p> <p>This is a Level 2 Event.</p> <p>Contest duration will be THREE minutes.</p>

	<p>Shime-waza and Kansetsu-waza will NOT be allowed.</p> <p>The contest winner will be determined by Scores and then Penalties.</p> <p>If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the contest the Players will immediately start a 3-minute Golden Score Contest</p> <p>The first score or penalty awarded will decide the winner.</p> <p>If the scores and penalties are level at the end of the Golden Score contest, the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>Conduct against the 'Spirit of Judo' will be penalised.</p>
Weigh-in:	<p>Male: 1030 - 1045 hrs Female: 1045 - 1100 hrs</p>
	<p>An OPEN weigh-in will be used:</p> <p>REQUIREMENTS:</p> <p>Gender Dress Code</p> <p>Female Must wear a t-shirt/ rash guard, with competition legal trousers</p> <p>Male U18 Must wear a t-shirt/ rash guard, with competition legal trousers</p> <p>Male 18 + Can choose to wear a t-shirt/ rash guard, but must wear competition legal trousers</p>
Contest Start:	<p>Male 1115 hrs – Approximately. Female 1200 hrs - Approximately</p> <p>There will be a presentation on the rules of the competition at the commencement of each category.</p>
Entry Fee:	<p>£20</p>
Spectators:	<p>FREE – All coaches and spectators.</p>
