<b>Level:</b>	British Judo Association Level <b>TWO</b> Competition.
<b>Participation:</b>	<p>Male and Female players who are a minimum of 14 years and older.</p> <p>Competitors must be members of the British Judo Association, or British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association.</p> <p>Competitors must be Novice to Blue belt maximum.</p>
<b>Mode:</b>	<p>Players will be check – weighed-in, on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with players as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience.</p> <p>The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club.</p> <p>All competitors will receive a medal.</p> <p>Medals will be presented on the mat after the group finishes.</p> <p>This is a Level 2 Event.</p> <p>Contest duration will be three minutes.</p> <p>Shime-Waza and Kansetsu-waza <b><u>WILL</u></b> be allowed.</p> <p>Please note that these contests may be refereed by one referee only.</p>

## SECTION THREE

	<p>The winner will be determined by Scores and then Penalties. If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the contest the Players will immediately start a 3-minute Golden Score Contest.</p> <p>The first score or penalty awarded will decide the winner.</p> <p>If the scores and penalties are level at the end of the Golden Score contest, the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority.</p> <p>Conduct against the 'Spirit of Judo' will be penalised.</p>

<b>Weighing in Policy:</b>	<p><b>An OPEN weigh-in will be used:</b></p> <p>REQUIREMENTS:</p> <p>Gender      Dress Code</p> <p>Female      Must wear a t-shirt/ rash guard, with competition legal trousers</p> <p>Male U18    Must wear a t-shirt/ rash guard, with competition legal trousers</p> <p>Male 18 +    Can choose to wear a t-shirt/ rash guard, but must wear competition legal trousers</p>
