Participation:	Male and Female players who are a minimum of 14 years and older. Competitors must be members of the British Judo Association, or British Judo Council or Amateur Judo Association. Competitors must be Novice to Blue belt maximum.
Mode:	Players will be check – weighed-in, on the day (at the venue) and will be placed into pools of three, four or five with players as close as possible to their own age/weight/grade and experience. The organisers will, where possible, separate players from the same school and club. All competitors will receive a medal. Medals will be presented on the mat after the group finishes. This is a Level 2 Event. Contest duration will be three minutes. Shime-Waza and Kansetsu-waza WILL be allowed. Please note that these contests may be refereed by one referee only.

	The winner will be determined by Scores and then Penalties. If the players are level on Scores and Penalties at the end of the contest the Players will immediately start a 3-minute Golden Score Contest. The first score or penalty awarded will decide the winner. If the scores and penalties are level at the end of the Golden Score contest, the Referee(s) will decide the winner on superiority. Conduct against the 'Spirit of Judo' will be penalised.
