Eligibility:	<p>All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the NIJF/BJA/IJA (IJA members resident in Northern Ireland)</p> <p><u>MINI/MAXIMON</u></p> <p>Players must be 8 years old to compete and maximum age is 14.</p> <p>All Mon grades eligible to compete.</p> <p><u>Minimum weight limit to compete is 25kg.</u></p> <p><u>(Armlocks and strangles will not be permitted in any Maximon groups.)</u></p> <p><u>KYU GRADES</u></p> <p>Players must be 15 years and over to compete Maximum grade – Brown belt (1st Kyu/18th Mon)</p> <p>(Armlocks and strangles will be permitted in groups with Green (3rd Kyu) to Brown (1st Kyu) belts only).</p> <p>It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete i.e. age and grade.</p>
Competition Format:	<p>Categories will be fought in pools (or pools/knockout depending on numbers entered)</p> <p>Contest time: Mini/Maximon - 3 mins Kyu Grades (15+) – 4 mins</p> <p>The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.</p> <p>Please note the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to Maximon categories which include players age 12 and below. <p><u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event – (plus a plain white round neck t-shirt for female competitors)</u></p> <p>This tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes (Kyu Grades).</p>

Categories:	<p>There are no set weight categories. All players will be sorted into groups based on age, weight and grade <u>depending on entries</u>. PLEASE ENSURE WEIGHT IS ACCURATE ON THE ENTRY FORM.</p> <p>There will be no more than 6 in each group.</p> <p>There will be one Gold medal, one Silver medal and two Bronze medals (numbers depending) presented in each group.</p>
Registration and Weigh-In:	<p><u>Sunday 19th May 2024</u></p> <p>Kyu Grades (15+) - 9.15am to 09:30am</p> <p>Mini/Maximon 8 to11 years – Weigh in time will be notified after the competition closing date. Mini/Maximon 12 to 14 years – Weigh in time will be notified after the competition closing date.</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo licence/membership card to registration and also their record book showing their grade.</p> <p><u>An open weigh-in will be conducted at this event therefore ALL</u> competitors must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt.</p> <p>Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area. The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area.</p>
Competition Start:	<p>Sunday 19th May 2024</p> <p>Competition starts: 10:30am (Kyu grades 15+ yrs) 1:00pm approx. (Mini/Maximons)</p>
Closing Date:	<p>Friday 10th May 2024</p> <p><i>Northern Ireland Judo Federation reserve the right to close the entry prior to the published closing date if the maximum entry number permitted is reached.</i></p>
