You will be emailed on or before 9pm on 20th November confirming the contest time. Please arrive 15 minutes before your given time to avoid congestion and delays. Players not present by the given time may be excluded from the event, or may be fitted into any available pool.

Players will be grouped according to weight, age, grade and experience and not in strict weight groups.

OPEN TO

All BJA / BJC / AJA licence holders.

You <u>must produce your Association's current licence on the day confirming your grade, or for BJA players</u> proof via The Dojo Your licence book must show a grading within 6 months of the date of the competition unless entering as a novice of under 6 months. No licence no entry.

All contests are 2 minutes. Contests will be in pools. Some pools may have to be merged. Red belts will not be allowed to fight Orange belts in any merged pool.

Medals will be presented as soon as possible after each group has finished. Any queries or disputes on or off the mat will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision is final. The competition is run under BJA rules as per the Tournament Handbook. ALL <u>players must have</u> a white compliant judogi.
