Eligibility:	All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the NIJF/BJA/IJA (Resident in Northern Ireland)
	KYU GRADES
	Players must be 14 years old and over to compete Maximum grade – Brown belt (1 st Kyu/18 th Mon)
	Armlocks and strangles will be permitted in groups with Green (3 rd Kyu/10 th Mon) to Brown (1 st Kyu/18th Mon) belts only.
	MON GRADES
	Players must be 8 years old to compete and the maximum age is 13.
	Grades - Novice/white belt to 12 th Mon/green belt (IJA 8 th Mon/green belt)
	Minimum weight limit – 25kg
	MON GRADES - This is a developmental event for beginner/intermediate players. Players who have competed at higher level events ie. N I Open, N I Closed, Irish Open, All Irelands or any UK mainland event are not eligible to enter the Mon Grades competition.
	It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete ie age, grade and minimum weight limit.
Competition Format:	Categories will be fought in pools (or pools/knockout depending on numbers entered).
	Kyu Grades
	Contest time: 4 mins
	There will be one Gold medal, one Silver medal and one/two Bronze medals (depending on number in group) presented in each group.
	This tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes (1st Kyu Grades).
	Mon Grades
	Contest time: 3 mins
	There will be one Gold medal, one Silver medal and remainder of Bronze medals presented in each group.
	The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.

	BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to Mon Grades categories with ages 8-11 years

Weight Categories:	There are no set weight categories. All players will be sorted into groups based on age, weight and grade depending on entries. Kyu Grades will be sorted into the following categories (depending on entry numbers)
	Upper Kyu – 1 st Kyu grades
	Middle Kyu – 2 nd & 3 rd Kyu grades
	Lower Kyu – 4 th 5 th and 6 th Kyu grades
	Lower Ryu = 4 3 and 6 Ryu grades
Registration and Weigh-In:	Sunday 20 th October 2024
	Kyu Grades – 08.45am to 9.00am
	Mon Grades age 8 & 9 years – 12.45pm to 1.15pm (may be subject to change depending on entries)
	Mon Grades age 10 to 13 years – 2.15pm to 2.30pm (may be subject to change depending on entries)
	An open weigh in will take place at this event therefore <u>all</u> players must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt (plain white round neck if wearing a t-shirt when competing).
	All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo membership/licence to registration and also their Record Book showing their grade. <u>Digital memberships must be able to be accessed to show valid date and member's grade.</u>
	Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.
	The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area (except to access a digital membership).
Competition Start:	Sunday 20 th October 2024 Competition starts: 10.00am (Kyu grades 14 yrs +) 1.30pm approx. (Mon Grades 8-13 years)
Closing Date:	Friday 11 th October 2024
