Sheffield University Kyu Grade Tournament (SUKT)

An Open British Judo Association Level 3 Point Scoring Event

Date: Saturday 30th November 2024
Venue: Goodwin Sports Centre, Northumberland Road, Sheffield, S10 2TY

Eligibility

This is an open kyu grade senior event. Competitors will be required to produce a valid, in date **FULL** BJA (or affiliate) licence along with their record book. Recreational and pay as you throw licences are not valid for competition
Mon grades should enter the equivalent senior colour grade for that section.
All competitors must have graded within the last 12 months (excluding 1st Kyu) and grades recorded in a record book (licence).

Categories

Novice to Yellow belt (5th Kyu)
Orange belt (4th Kyu) to Blue belt (2nd Kyu)
Brown belt (1st Kyu) points scoring

	Weight groups (Under / Over Kg)
Men	U66, U73, U81, U90, O90
Women	U57, U63, U70, O70

If entering one of the open weight groups (Over 90Kg / Over 70Kg) please provide actual weight when entering in addition to weight category.

We reserve the right to merge weight groups if necessary

Weigh in information

Weigh-ins will begin at **08:30**, with lower grades first, then middle and then 1st Kyu, with lighter players first in each. Exact timings for weigh-ins for each category will be announced on the website and/or socials in the week before the event.

	Dress Code	Weight allowance
Female	Must wear a t-shirt/ rash guard*, with competition legal trousers	0.8 Kg
Male U18	Must wear a t-shirt/ rash guard*, with competition legal trousers	0.8 kg
Male 18 and over	Can choose to wear a t-shirt/ rash guard*, but must wear competition legal trousers	0.7kg for trousers only, +0.1kg if t-shirt/ rash guard is worn

*T- Shirts / rash guards should be white and crew neck with no or only a small motif on
