Categories	A: CADETS (players aged 14-17 yrs inclusive) Entries will be grouped by standard cadet weight categories where possible B: SENIORS Low grade (players aged 14+ yrs) (6th- 3rd Kyu, red-green belt) NOT point scoring C: SENIORS High grade (players aged 14+ yrs) (2nd kyu and above, blue-black belt) point scoring Entries will be grouped by standard senior weight categories where possible

Registration & Weigh In	Section A – 8.30am to 9.00am contest starting approx. 9.30. Male & All Females Section B - Updated times will be shared after closing date and published by Facebook and Email All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a plain white round neck t-shirt/rashguard for weigh-in and competing. Weight allowance of 0.8kg (U18's), 0.7kg judogi trousers only
Medals	Gold, Silver, Bronze, Bronze. In a pooled weight division, judoka must have won a contest to receive a medal.
General	Photographs may also be taken for promotional purposes including publication on club websites. By completing an entry form you indicate your acceptance of these conditions and parents (in the absence of any expressed objection) provide their consent to the taking and use of photos/videos.
