<b>Eligibility</b>	All competitors must be aged 8 years to 15 years on the day of the event and hold a <b>FULL</b> valid BJA membership or affiliate – (introductory memberships are not valid for competition) which must be produced at time of registration and weigh-in. Ensure your competitor has graded and has competitive experience.
<b>Categories</b>	<b>A: Under 12 Orange Belt and Below (players aged 8-11yrs)</b> BJA U12 Restrictions will apply  <b>B: 12-15 years, Blue Belt &amp; Below (players aged 12-15yrs)</b> No Armlocks or strangles permitted

<b>Method of Competition</b>	Pools. Pools/Crossover where appropriate.  The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine or alter categories should entries dictate. Considerations of grade, weight and age will be considered where possible. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director will be final.
<b>Registration &amp; Weigh In</b>	Section A – Weigh in – 8.30 to 9.00am contest starting approx. 9.30. Section B – Weigh in times will be confirmed after the closing date by Facebook & email  All competitors <b>MUST</b> present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a plain white round neck t-shirt/rashguard for weigh-in and competing. Weight allowance of 0.8kg
<b>Medals</b>	Gold, Silver, Bronze, Bronze.  In a pooled weight division, judoka must have won a contest to receive a medal.
<b>General</b>	Photographs may also be taken for promotional purposes including publication on club websites. By completing an entry form you indicate your acceptance of these conditions and parents (in the absence of any expressed objection) provide their consent to the taking and use of photos/videos. <b>NO Flash photography.</b> The event is run in line with BJA Child Protection Policy  The wearing of BLUE & WHITE judogi is not compulsory at this event. However White judogi is <u>priority</u> . <b>Players area requested to bring their own Blue &amp; White Belts</b> The decision of the Tournament Organiser is final. <b>NO JU-JITSU SUITS ALLOWED</b>
